Environmental management policy

This is a written statement outlining our company's mission in relation to managing the environmental effects and aspects of our operations.

Having recognised responsibility for environmental matters we place a particularly high priority on environmental issues with regards to company operations and the range of services provided.

We operate a policy of continual improvements and change in accordance with developing knowledge and changing environmental requirements.

We are aware of the environmental sensitivity of the sector in which we operate and seek to continually develop company environmental policy.

Due to the need for ongoing improvement it is not possible to detail fully company activities with regards to the environment, but the following objectives form the basis of our policy.

We aim to protect and improve the environment through good management and by adopting best practice wherever possible.

We work to integrate environmental considerations into our business decisions and adopt greener alternatives wherever possible throughout our operations.

In all our activities we aspire to:

- ✦ *Comply fully with all relevant legal requirements, codes of practice and regulations*
- ✦ *Prevent pollution to land, air and water*
- ✦ *Reduce water and energy use*
- ✦ *Minimise waste and increase recycling within the framework of our waste management procedures*
- ✦ *Identify and manage environmental risks and hazards*
- ✦ *Involve clients, partners, suppliers and subcontractors in the implementation of our objectives*
- ✦ *Promote environmentally responsible purchasing*
- ✦ *Provide suitable training to enable employees to deal with their specific areas of environmental control*
- ✦ *Improve the environmental efficiency of our transport and travel arrangements*
- ✦ *Establish targets to measure the continuous improvement in our environmental performance*

All employees are responsible for working towards the objectives contained within this policy

The company believes in the importance of caring for the environment and will work actively with its clients to minimise environmental impact of its works by:

- ✦ *Where the company is not bound by a definitive specification it will endeavour to source materials from manufacturers who show a commitment to the environment as shown by their established policy, environmental management systems and commitment to verifiable environmental standards*
- ✦ *Where suitable access and storage facilities are available every endeavour will be made to deliver materials in bulk direct from the factory to minimise the number of journeys and the need for double handling*
- ✦ *Where direct deliveries are not possible preference will be given to obtaining materials from local sources*
- ✦ *The individual requirements and specific restrictions for each site will be considered when ordering materials to ensure that these are supplied in the optimum sizes to minimise waste either during handling or in use*
- ✦ *Working practises will be developed for each site to ensure that the level of waste is kept to the minimum*
- ✦ *Where suitable recycling facilities are provided we will ensure that all waste is segregated into the appropriate bins (i.e. general waste, plasterboard, metal waste, cardboard and plastic packaging)*

Our general environmental objectives are to:

- ✦ *Comply with all government regulations & guidance, relevant legislation and environmental codes of practice within the industry*
- ✦ *Minimise waste through planning and management of the works onsite*
- ✦ *Ensure all staff are aware of our environmental policy and accept their responsibility to work towards minimising waste*
- ✦ *Endeavour to minimise detrimental effects on the local environment and community particularly in terms of noise and disruption*
- ✦ *Encourage our suppliers to support us in our pursuance of continuous improvements of environmental performance*
- ✦ *Maximise the amount of documentation that can be transmitted electronically thereby conserving paper and reducing postage costs*

Notwithstanding the foregoing it must be recognised that the majority of works undertaken by the company involve the use of specified materials on sites managed by main contractors, in these situations the company may suggest as appropriate the selection of materials and including the manner in which they are packaged or delivered by the supplier, similarly the company may suggest as appropriate the manner in which waste materials are disposed of by the main contractor. The company is committed to playing its part in the overall supply chain to minimise the environmental impact of its operations and will work with all parties on each project to achieve this objective. We minimise energy consumption through efficient use of electrical appliances, air conditioning systems and hot water systems and encourage the use of renewable energy sources. We constantly update our knowledge and ability to satisfy the increasing need to obtain positive benefits from the volumes of material which come under our control which means that the issue of recycling, waste minimisation, waste to energy and the most environmentally appropriate disposal options are continually assessed and reviewed.

The environmental policy is one of continual review and is subject to regular review and development. Our continued environmental responsibility is judged by our client base and the general public whilst being driven by the managing director through management structure.
